Applications must be received by: Monday, June 5, 2017

The banners may be displayed on The BLVD for up to six (6) months.

Banner Information

To be chosen, the following criteria must be satisfied:

- Nominee must be currently serving or have served between World War I to current date.
- Nominee must have served in a combat theater identified by the federal court.
- Nominee must have lived in the Antelope Valley for a minimum of two years at some point in his/her life.
- Veterans: Nominee must have been discharged honorably (paperwork may be required).
- Nominator must submit a high resolution photograph, either digital or original print along with this application.
 - Must be in military uniform, boot camp photo preferred.
- * These are minimum requirements. Selections will be made at the discretion of the City of Lancaster.

Location of banners: (The BLVD between Beech Avenue and Genoa Avenue)

Important Applications that meet the criteria and are submitted prior to the deadline will be used, banner space permitting. A maximum of 30 nominees will be accepted. All others will be kept on file for future use.
