WHAT IS THE LANCASTER CORPORATE CHALLENGE?

It is an Olympic style competition that promotes teambuilding, fun and fitness. The Lancaster Corporate Challenge (LCC) was launched by the City's Wellness Committee as a way to create a community movement towards a healthy lifestyle – a factor known to help reduce health care costs.
