Freezers, refrigerators, stoves and ranges, couches, sofas, chairs, tires, gasoline or any other form of household hazardous waste.

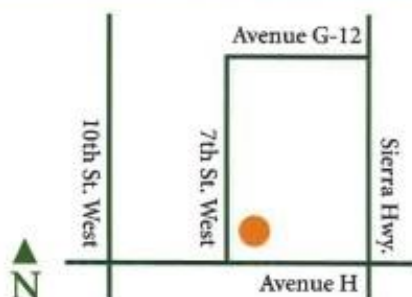

## What can be made from recycled E-Waste?

Nearly all of the materials you bring to the 24-Hour Recycling Center can be recovered to make new products.

E-Waste contains a number of different useful and valuable metals. These can be used to create new automotive catalytic converters and plumbing faucets. They also are used in the design and manufacture of Olympic medals.

Plastic found within electronic waste can also be recycled into garden furniture, license plate frames, durable non-food containers and auto parts. Many plastics have high thermal value and are used as fuel.
